Facts: On 7/9/91, Pltf., a 37-year-old homemaker at the time, was a passenger in a vehicle that was struck in the rear by

Deft.'s car on the Whitestone Bridge. Deft. conceded liability and this trial was on damages only.

<u>Injuries</u>: herniated disc at L3-4; lumbar radiculopathy. Deft. denied that Pltf. sustained a serious injury under the No-Fault Law, Insurance Law § 5102(d), and disputed the existence of the herniated disc. <u>Demonstrative evidence</u>: MRIs. Offer: \$20,000; demand: \$100,000 (policy). <u>Jury deliberation</u>: 3 hours. <u>Carrier</u>: State Farm. <u>Pltf. Expert</u>: Dr. Sana Bloch, neurologist, Bronx. <u>Deft. Experts</u>: Dr. Angelito Tan, neurologist, Mineola; Dr. Sondra Pfeffer, radiologist,

Manhattan.
